For the past 20 years, the Foundation for Special People (FFSP) has provided social and recreational activities to enrich and normalize the lives of children and adults who have developmental, emotional, medical and physical disabilities such as mental retardation, cerebral palsy, down syndrome, autism, schizophrenia, blindness, and hearing impairment.

We believe that individuals with developmental disabilities deserve the same opportunities as everyone in the general population. We provide these individuals with an environment to experience, learn, and discover the simple joys of everyday life through social recreational activities. The activities are designed to provide the framework for developing friendships and widening the circle of support in the community.

Three annual events offered through FFSP are the "Sweetheart Ball" in February, the "Western Extravaganza" in April, and the "Snowflake Ball" in December held at the Proud Bird Restaurant in Los Angeles. Approximately 200 to 300 individuals with developmental disabilities attend each of the events each year. These three major events give these individuals a chance to dress in their finest attire, interact with others in a festive environment, enjoy a formal, sit-down meal, and dance to a live band.

FFSP offers special events throughout the year. These events have included a Halloween Party and Dance, Day at the Races, Festival of Lights in Newport Beach, Disneyland, Disney Adventures, Knott's Berry Farm, Magic Mountain, Universal Studio, Aquarium of the Pacific, bowling, and movies. Travel Camps are offered during the summer months and provide unique vacation experiences for individuals who are 21 years of age and older.

Traveling by coach bus, train, ship or airplane, excursions include destinations such as San Diego, Santa Barbara, Monterey, San Francisco, Sacramento, Arizona, Florida, Laughlin, Reno, Las Vegas, Lake Tahoe, Hawaii, and Mexico cruises. FFSP also offers lodging and activities for special needs relatives of out-of-state families vacationing in California.

Many of our special people need financial assistance in order to be able to participate in our many activities and events. As a non-profit organization, we depend on the support of the community and the general public.
